Jennifer Kiser Lloyd has been with the Florida Healthy Kids Corporation since January 1997. As the Corporation's Director of External Affairs her responsibilities include managing the Corporation's procurement processes and corporate contracts, providing support and assistance to community based organizations and local governments, tracking state and federal legislative activities and overseeing the Corporation's communications and community relations efforts.

Additionally, Ms. Lloyd served as the Deputy Director of the Healthy Kids Replication Program from 1999 - 2002. The Healthy Kids Replication Program was a National Program Office of the Robert Wood Johnson Foundation. As the Deputy Director, Ms. Lloyd was responsible for the oversight of the NPO's grantees and the provision of technical assistance to grantee states and other organizations involved in children's health insurance programs.

Ms. Lloyd was previously with Healthy Kids in 1992 - 1993 serving as an administrative assistant with the Corporation and was responsible for writing the Corporation's first Administrative Policy and Procedures Manual. She also acted as the Corporation's local liaison for Pinellas County from 1995-1996.

Ms. Lloyd received her Bachelor's Degree in Political Science from Florida State University in 1991 and earned her Juris Doctor Degree from Stetson University's College of Law in December 1996.
